**OCTOBER 2ND
2023**

- Households with a senior 60 years of age or older
- Disabled person(s) receiving disability income from Social Security
- Families with Children Age 5 years and Under

**NOVEMBER 1ST
2023**

- Households that are disconnected from utilities or have current disconnection notice
- For Propane Customers, 25% or less of propane in tank, You are considered a disconnected household

**DECEMBER 1ST
2023**

- General Public

YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING:

- 1.) Social Security Cards for everyone in the household
- 2.) Gas and/or Electric Bill
- 3.) Proof of income for the past 30 days. If your household is zero-income, you will need a denial letter from unemployment and/or a food stamp print out.
- 4.) Current Medical Card

INCOME GUIDELINES For the 2024 Program Year

Family Size	200% 30 Day Income
1	\$2,430
2	\$3,287
3	\$4,143
4	\$5,000
5	\$5,857
6	\$6,713

These figures are based on the 2023 Federal Poverty Guidelines published in the US Department of Health and Human Services in the Federal Register/Volume 88/Number 12/January 19, 2023.

Given that HHS allows 150% of FPG or 60% of SMI, where 200% of FPG is lower than 60% of SMI the program will be using 200% of FPG as our highest category. However, for the household size of 8 to 11 members, the benefit at 200% would exceed the allowable 60% SMI. For households larger than 11 members, the 150% will be set as the maximum income eligibility criteria. The state reserves the right to adjust these levels based on the availability of federal appropriations.
